Conditions of Award

Grants and fellowships from the Isabel Jurado Foundation are provided to qualified medical researchers for the purpose of promoting medical research for MPSIII/Sanfilippo Syndrome. The following requirements are applicable to all grants and fellowships.

1. No institution overhead or other indirect costs will be paid and shall not be included as part of any grant request.
2. All funds awarded shall be used in accordance with the submitted and approved proposal and budget.
3. Research award payments will be made in two installments. The second half payment will follow submission of a one page mid-project report.
4. A final report must be submitted within 60 days of the completion of the project. If the results are published in any of the scientific journals, please so indicate and provide a copy of the article. The final report should include:
 - a. A summary of the results of the research project. Indicate whether initial goals of the project were met. If possible, state what research efforts are needed in the future in the same area.
 - b. Provide a summary statement in lay language of the results of the research. Such statement should be suitable for incorporation into the Isabel Jurado Foundation materials released to the general public.
5. All publications resulting from funded research must include the Isabel Jurado Foundation in their credits.
6. The recipient of any research grant awarded must certify in writing that any research conducted under such a grant will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The recipient must agree to indemnify and hold the National MPS Society harmless from any and all claims which may arise from such research.
7. All work involving human subjects must show documented compliance with NIH guidelines for human subjects as provided by the sponsoring institution's committee for clinical investigation. All work involving animal experimentation shall comply with NIH guidelines for care and use of laboratory animals.
8. Allowable Expenditures: It is intended that grant funds will be used to provide direct support to MPSIII research project but will not be used to underwrite the senior scientists' regular salaries. Funds may be used for equipment essential to the project and for specified consumable supplies. Grant monies are not to be used to cover general overhead of the institution involved.

Method of Evaluation

All applications will be reviewed and ranked by board members of the Isabel Jurado Foundation.
